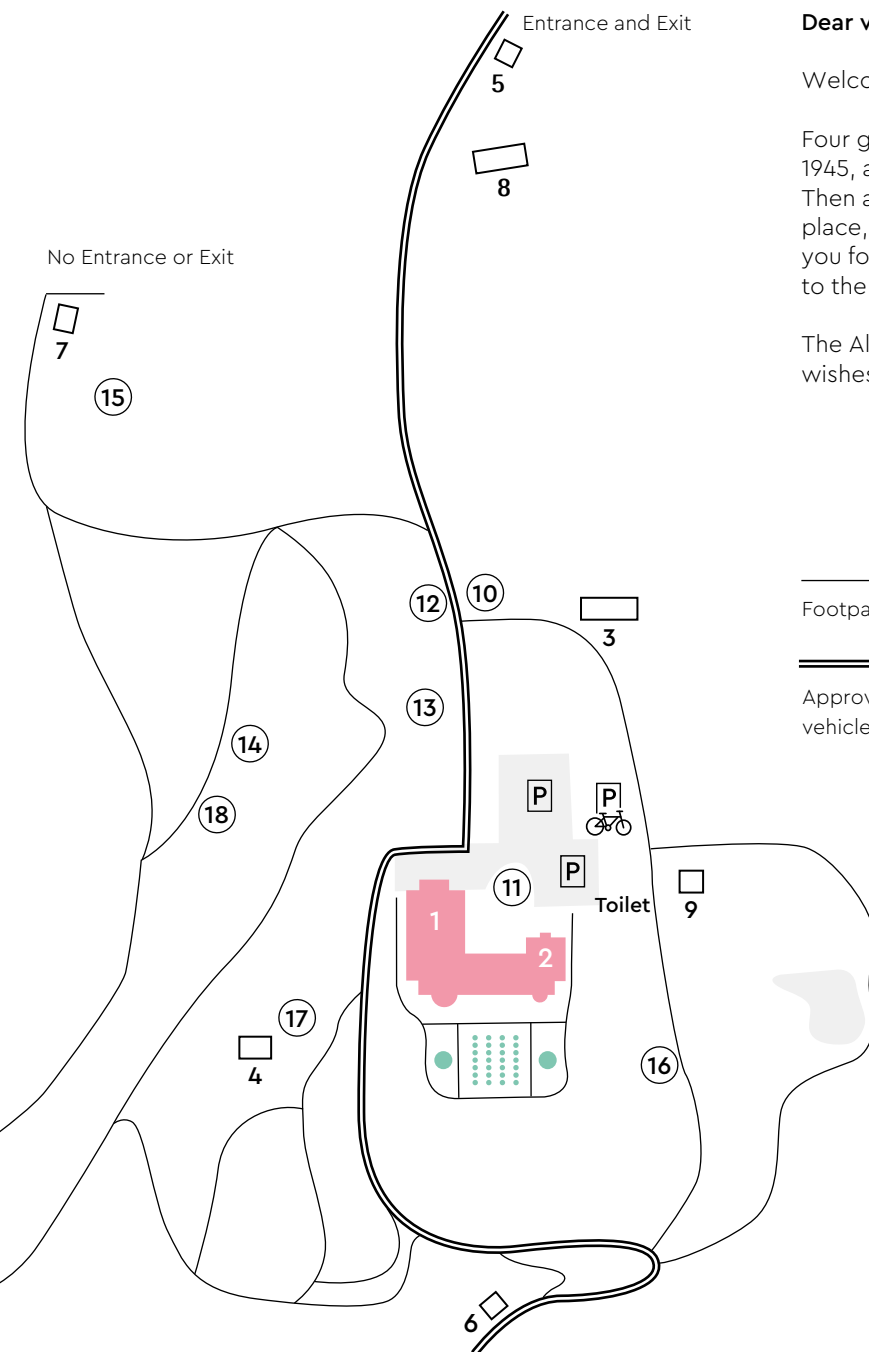

House and Park Rules

Hügel Park is home and habitat to numerous plants and animals, some of which are rare. Therefore, the Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Foundation asks that you:

- drive carefully and park vehicles only in designated parking areas,
- use designated roads and paths to protect flora and fauna,
- keep buildings and park clean,
- refrain from smoking in the buildings and in the park.

Dogs – with the exception of assistance dogs – are generally not allowed on the property.

Photo shootings for commercial or private purposes are not permitted.

You enter the buildings and park at **your own risk**.

By entering, you agree to the house and park rules.

The **supervisory staff** will be happy to assist you with any questions you may have. At the same time, we kindly ask you to follow their instructions.
